AUGUST BIRTHSTONE Researched by:

Two birthstones are available for August birthdays: *Peridot* and *Sardonyx*.



PERIDOT

Peridot is said to host magical powers and healing properties to protect against nightmares and to bring the wearer power, influence, and a wonderful year. As peridot is a gemstone that forms deep inside the Earth and brought to the surface by volcanoes, in Hawaii, peridot symbolizes the tears of Pele, the goddess

of fire and volcanoes. Today, most of the peridot supply comes from Arizona; other sources are China, Myanmar, and Pakistan. This gemstone comes in several color variations ranging from yellowish green to brown, but most consumers are attracted to the bright lime greens and olive greens. Peridot, in smaller sizes, often is used in beaded necklaces and bracelets.



SARDONY

Sardonyx is a variety of the silica mineral called chalcedony. This sort of mineral contains layers of tiny quartz fibers, which are stacked on top of each other to

give a banded appearance. The layers in these stones range from translucent to opaque. The stones vary in color, too. They may be white or gray, ranging to many colorful varieties.

Sardonyx stones usually contain flat-banded, white and brownish-red bands. The word Sardonyx is derived from the Greek, Sard meaning "reddish brown," and onyx meaning "veined gem." The best stones are found in India. They are also found in Germany, Czechoslovakia, Brazil, and Uruguay. In the United States, sardonyx can be found in the Lake Superior region and in Oregon.



AUGUST BIRTH FLOWER

The August flower is the Gladiolus. Glads, as they are often called, are native tropical and South Africa and are any plant of the genus Gladiolus. The phas sword-shaped leaves with one-sided spikes of funnel-shaped, bright flowers.

Discovered in South Africa in the 17th and 18th centuries, the gladiolus was used as a food. In ancient Rome, gladiator battles were fought 'to the death or gladioli' where the victor was buried under gladioli by cheering crowds in celebration for winning the fight.

It was from this history that the glad has also become known as the 'sword lily' and referred to as the flower of the Roman gladiators. The meaning attached to the flower is that of moral character.

The name for the flower is from the Latin word 'gladius' which means sword, a reference to the shape of the plant leaves.

The earliest written reference to the glad is in The Bible in the Book of Matthew (6:28) which states, "And why take ye thought for raiment? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not, neither do they spin."

Hybridization and experimentation started around 1800 in Britain with the earliest known Africa gladiolus grown in Europe dating back to 1680.

Europeans were aware of this flower for centuries as an inhabitant of fields where corn grew around the Mediterranean Sea.



The other August flower is the poppy.
