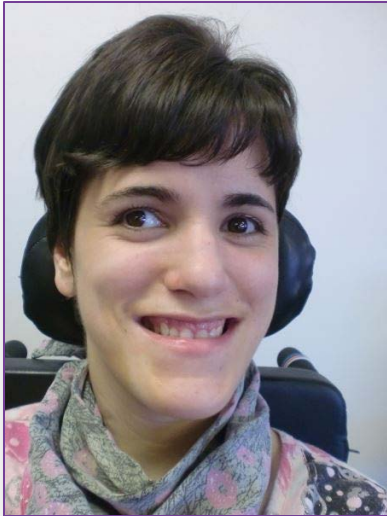
The trilogy that sprouted up produced thinking, opinion, and inspiration that has lasted well into the last four decades!

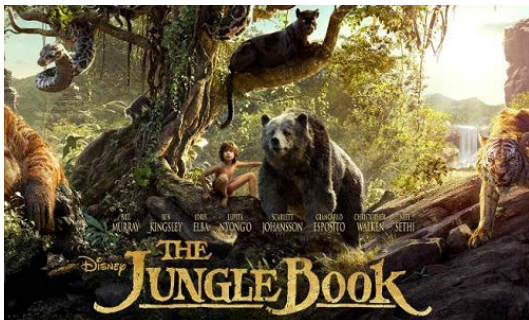

On March 23rd, we had two visitors for Current Events. Tyler and Nick showed videos about Basic Training for combat. They showed, first hand, what it is like to be in the army. It can take four to nine months for basic training. Tyler was trained to repair and fly a military helicopters. Nick was trained for infantry using weaponry. The drill sergeants tell them what to do, and what field they go to. Tyler was stationed in Georgia. Nick was stationed in Ft. Riley, Kansas. Soldiers are given drug tests about every three weeks. They wear a uniform when they are on duty. They have a US flag patch on their shoulder to represent the US. They use rifles and grenade launchers. There are army tanks and trucks for battle. When civilians join the army, they get their heads shaved and are given an army hat or helmet. They go around the world to do battle, like to Syria or Iraq. Many participants at AE also have or had family in the service. In ILS class many of the participants wrote letters to soldiers.

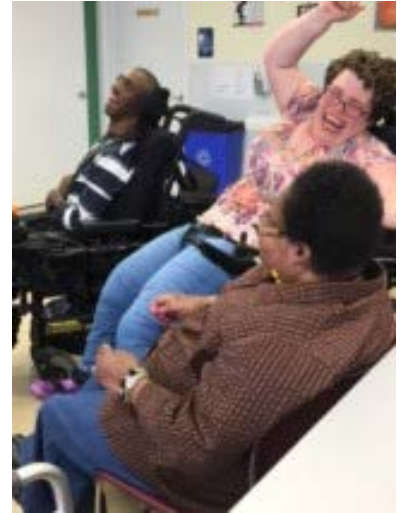

DANCING CLASS

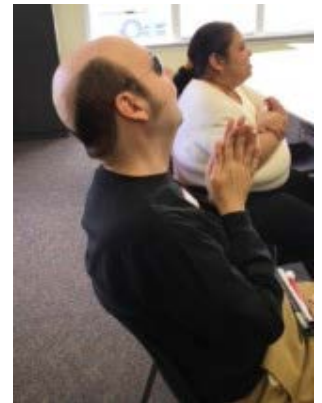
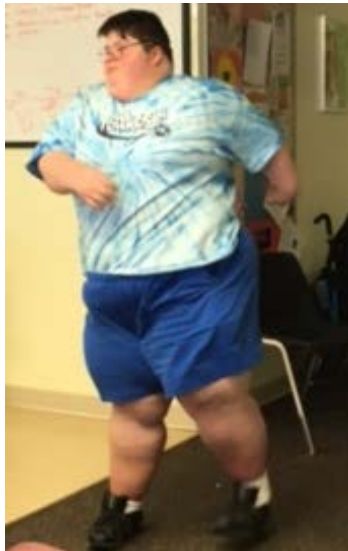

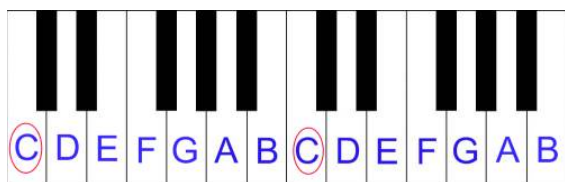

Arts & Crafts

In Art & Crafts we made bird seed ornaments. We took turns stirring birdseed into oil. We used cookie cutters to make shapes like hearts, shamrocks, leaves, stars, and gingerbread. Then we put the birdseed shapes onto a cookie sheet, so it could dry. We pressed the birdseed into the cookie cutters. After the birdseed dried, the participants took one ornament home and hung the rest on the trees and fences around AE.

What you'll need

Bird seed (we use a wild bird variety)
Unflavored gelatin
Boiling water
Large cookie cutters
Straws cut into 2 inch pieces
Large bowl
Spoon
Baking sheet
Parchment or wax paper
String (we like to use jute or baker's twine)



1. Dissolve 2 tablespoons (or 2 individual packets) of gelatin in 2/3 cup of boiling water
2. When gelatin is completely dissolved, add 2 cups of bird seed.
3. Mix for 2 to 3 minutes to allow the seeds to soak up the gelatin mixture. Depending on how absorbent your seeds are, you may have some excess gelatin mixture--not to fret! It won't matter one bit in the end.
4. Place your cookie cutters onto a parchment- or wax paper-lined baking sheet and carefully fill them with the bird seed mixture (this gives those developing motor skills a great workout!) Be sure to overfill them just a bit, because you'll want the seeds to be nice and tight inside the cookie cutters.
Cover the filled cookie cutters with another sheet of parchment or wax paper and press the seeds down firmly.

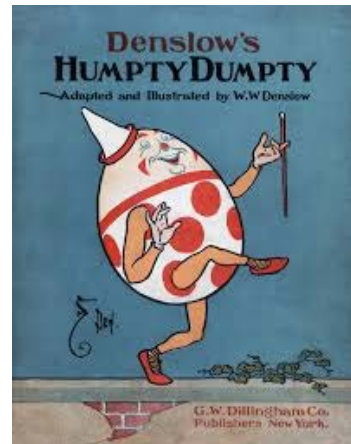


