White Cane Safety Day in the United States

White Cane Safety Day recognizes blind and visually impaired people, their achievements and how the white cane has helped them.

White canes provide the visually impaired with greater mobility within their communities. Blind and visually impaired people have used canes as mobility tools for centuries, but it was not until after World War I that the white cane was properly introduced. In modern times, there are different varieties of white canes, each serving slightly varied needs.

Many blind and visually impaired people, including famous musicians and writers, have made major positive contributions in the United States. Many have also used a white cane to help them succeed at educational institutions, work environments, and their homes.

We have participants who use white canes at AE. We try to give them extra space when they walk with their canes.

Kathy S. - Sometimes staff help guide them with verbal prompts to where they are heading. Jonathan W - Always say 'hi' to them, and introduce yourself, so they know who you are.

WHAT IS COLUMBUS DAY?

In 1492 The Explorer Columbus discovered The Americas. Columbus Day is celebrated every year on October 12. The three ships Columbus brought over for Spain was Pinta, Nina, and the Santa Maria. When asked about the three ship that Columbus sailed, Victor knew that one of the ships was named Santa Maria.

Columbus Day is a national holiday in many countries in the Americas and elsewhere which officially celebrates the anniversary of Christopher Columbus's arrival in the Americas on October 12, 1492. The landing is celebrated as "Columbus Day" in the United States, as "Día de la Raza" in many countries in Latin America, as "Día de la Hispanidad" and "Fiesta Nacional" in Spain, where it is also the religious festivity of la Virgen del Pilar, as Día de las Américas in Belize and Uruguay, as Día del Respeto a la Diversidad Cultural in Argentina, and as Giornata Nazionale di Cristoforo Colombo or Festa Nazionale di Cristoforo Colombo in Italy and in the Little Italys around the world. These holidays have been celebrated unofficially since the late 18th century and officially in various countries since the early 20th Century.

National Mad Hatter Day

October 6 is a day set aside each year to celebrate National Mad Hatter Day. The fictional character, The Hatter (also known as The Mad Hatter) from *Alice's Adventures in Wonderland*, typically acts silly. A group of computer technicians in Boulder, Colorado first celebrated Mad Hatter Day in 1986 as a day of silliness. The date, October 6th, was chosen due to the label tucked in the Mad Hatter's hat band that read "In this style 10/6".

The phrase "mad as a hatter" comes from the late 18th and early 19th centuries when haberdasheries used mercury nitrate. The exposure to this metal over time caused the tradesmen to develop symptoms making people believe they were mad.

Sweet Cornbread with Honey Butter

This is excellent cornbread...especially topped with honey-butter! To make cornbread muffins, just spoon batter into greased or paper-lined muffin cups and bake for about 18 minutes.

1/2 cup cornmeal
1-1/2 cups flour
2/3 cup sugar
1 tbsp. baking powder
1/2 tsp. salt
1/3 cup oil
3 tbsp. melted butter
1 tbsp. honey
2 eggs, beaten
1-1/4 cups milk
Honey-butter, optional



Combine cornmeal, flour, sugar, baking powder and salt in medium bowl. Add oil, butter, honey, eggs and milk; stir until just blended. Pour into greased 8-inch square baking pan. Bake in preheated 350: oven for 35 minutes. Yield: 9 large squares or one round cake pan.

*To make honey-butter, whip 1/2 cup butter with electric mixer until fluffy. Mix in 2 tbsp. honey, or to taste.

AMERICAN HALLOWEEN TRADITIONS CONTRIBUTED BY NEWSLETTER GROUP



The American Halloween tradition of "trick-or-treating" probably dates back to the early All Souls' Day parades in England. During the festivities, poor citizens would beg for food and families would give them pastries called "soul cakes" in return for their promise to pray for the family's dead relatives. The distribution of soul cakes was encouraged by the church as a way to

replace the ancient practice of leaving food and wine for roaming spirits. The practice, which was referred to as "going a-souling" was eventually taken up by children who would visit the houses in their neighborhood and be given ale, food, and money.

The tradition of dressing in costume for Halloween has both European and Celtic roots. On Halloween, when it was believed that ghosts came back to the earthly world, people thought that they would encounter ghosts if they left their homes. To avoid being recognized by these ghosts, people would wear masks when they left their homes after dark so that the ghosts would mistake them for fellow spirits. On Halloween, to keep ghosts away from their houses, people would place bowls of food outside their homes to appease the ghosts and prevent them from attempting to enter.
